General Lab Safety Rules

Check Electrical Wiring: Avoid touching electrical equipment with wet hands. Ensure all electrical connections, plugs, UPS, and cables are properly insulated and arranged to prevent electric shock or short circuits.

No unauthorized entry: Only authorized students and staffs are allowed in the lab.

Use of Eyeglasses: Students prescribed with eyeglasses must wear them at all times in the lab to ensure proper vision and protect their eyes from strain or discomfort during computer use.

No Eating or Drinking: Taking food and drinks inside the lab is strictly prohibited.

Safety Procedures for all Equipments

- Stay on workstation and programs directed by the teacher.
- Never rename, delete, add, or remove anything from the computer unless directed by the teacher.
- Inform the teacher immediately when a computer is not working properly.
- Remain seated and work quietly.
- Do not share your username and password.
- Log in and out with your account only.
- Do not change any computer settings.
- Leave your computer area clean, push in the chair, and hang up the headphones when you leave.
- Failure to follow the rules could lead to loss of computer privileges.

Accident and Health Hazard Provisions

Fire Safety: Know the emergency exits and fire alarm locations. Evacuate immediately if a fire cannot be controlled.
